



Imperial Valley University Partnership - Student Agreement

The Imperial Valley University Partnership (IVUP) is an innovative educational initiative that offers a full college experience that is affordable, accessible and of high quality education. It is designed to enhance students' academic success, perseverance, retention and graduation with a bachelor's degree in four years. IVUP has high expectations of its students. To ensure success, students must work cooperatively with IVUP counselors to develop a personalized education plan.

As an IVUP student, you must make a commitment to the responsibilities outlined below:

1. IVUP students are responsible for reading and understanding the San Diego State University (SDSU) and Imperial Valley College (IVC) catalogs, which describe graduation requirements, academic policies, and procedures.
2. IVUP students must participate in appropriate IVUP support programs and events. These may include orientations, seminars, tutoring, and Early Start Program (if applicable).
3. IVUP students must verify personal contact information for accuracy on the SDSU Web Portal & IVC Webstar, particularly email, phone and mailing address, on a regular basis. IVUP students are responsible for updating contact information in a timely manner should changes to any of the above mentioned change.
4. IVUP students who are not exempt from the California State University (CSU) Entry Level Math (ELM) examination and/or English Placement Test (EPT) must successfully earn credit in designated courses by the end of the summer term of enrollment after their first year or be subject to disenrollment from SDSU.
5. IVUP students are required to meet with their IVUP counselor at least once per semester during the academic year and/or as recommended by counselors thereafter.
At IVC, IVUP students will receive access to priority registration for two years and will be responsible for registering themselves using WebStar Registration systems on their assigned date and time any time thereafter. Students will lose priority registration, if they are in academic probation.
6. At SDSU, IVUP students will be registered for courses, by SDSU staff, each semester during their freshman and sophomore years. IVUP students must take the courses assigned to them and cannot drop or change to a different course.
7. IVUP students will receive a standard academic plan for the major selected. Student academic plans might vary depending on English and Math remediation needs and/or Advanced Placement (AP) credit. Students must take the recommended courses in order to ensure graduation in 4 yrs.
8. IVUP students must inform the IVUP counselor and must submit official AP transcripts to SDSU and IVC before registration in order to ensure proper placement in courses.
9. IVUP students are required to submit official transcripts to SDSU from IVC and vice versa every semester.

Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the termination of your IVUP status, services and/or scholarship.
